

Director's Report on Developmental Progress Assessment

Overview:

Amir Bashar Abuassaf was assessed at our center on June 2nd, 2025. The evaluation identified **information processing delays** and **developmental delays**, which have contributed to **acquired features of autism** in his current developmental profile. While these features are present, further analysis and testing are needed to better understand the underlying causes and to develop a personalized intervention plan.

Recommended Plan:

1) Development Protocol for Information Processing

- Implement a **4-month intervention protocol** targeting the child's cognitive, adaptive, and social development.
- Conduct an **in-person reassessment** after 4 months to establish a developmental baseline and evaluate progress.
- Continue and adjust the intervention plan based on the child's response and needs.

2) Main Recommended Analysis (Conducted Through Neurazon – Canada):

Please refer to their report. These tests are performed externally through Neurazon (Canada). They are optional but strongly recommended to provide precision-based insights.

3) Recommended Therapy After Determining the Causes:

- **Neuroplasticity Rehabilitation Therapy:**
 - To begin in **later stages** of intervention once underlying causes are clarified and initial progress is seen.

- **Speech and Occupational Therapy:**

- Focused on building language skills, fine motor abilities, and overall adaptive functioning.


