

Director's Report on Developmental Progress Assessment

Overview

Yanal was assessed at our center for developmental progress. The evaluation revealed an **information processing delay** with **acquired autism features**, which are connected to developmental delays and a **potential variant found in previous analyses**. Encouragingly, Yanal has **shown improvement on the first protocols** and continues to demonstrate strong potential for further progress.

Recommended Plan

1. Development Protocol for Information Processing

1. Continue with a structured developmental protocol targeting information processing skills.
2. Duration: 3 months, followed by reevaluation (preferably in person).
3. Reassess baseline progress at reevaluation to adjust the plan accordingly.
4. Complete recommended sessions of therapy during this period.

2. Recommended Tests (Through Neurazon, Canada)

The recommended test is performed through **Neurazon (Canada)**. This is an external test, not conducted directly at our centers. Results will be reviewed and incorporated into the child's care plan upon completion. Please refer to their report and assessment.

3. Recommended Therapy

- **Neuroplasticity Rehabilitation Therapy:** To be introduced in later stages, as the child is not ready to begin yet.

Conclusion

This assessment confirms that Yanal presents with information processing delays and acquired autism features due to developmental delays and possible genetic contribution. The child has **already improved with previous protocols** and continues to show great potential for progress. Continued structured protocols, targeted analyses, and gradual therapy introduction will be critical to sustain and enhance improvement.

Notes on External Testing

The recommended **Functional Urine Analysis** is performed through **Neurazon (Canada)**. This is an external test, not conducted directly at our centers. Results will be reviewed and incorporated into the child's care plan upon completion.
