Director's Report on Developmental Progress Assessment

Overview:

Abdulrahman visited our center for a developmental progress assessment. The evaluation shows that he has **Down Syndrome with information processing delays and developmental delays**, which is expected within his genetic profile. Despite this, Abdulrahman demonstrates **cognitive skills appropriate for his age**, though his **information processing speed remains slower**, requiring targeted support.

The child also has a history of **autoimmune-related conditions**, including **vitaligo** and **previous hypothyroidism**, several of which have improved. These findings strongly indicate a **biological component** influencing his developmental and processing challenges.

Given these factors, further analysis is recommended to provide deeper insight into the underlying causes and guide personalized intervention.

Recommended Plan

1) Development Protocol for Information Processing

- Continue the development protocol for **4 months**, followed by a full reassessment (preferably in person).
- Reevaluate the plan and establish a new baseline to measure progress.
- Continue intervention steps according to his developmental response.

2) Recommended Tests (Through Neurazon Canada)

Note:

These tests are **external, optional**, and **not conducted directly through our center**. They are recommendations based on research and Neurazon's guidance.

3) Recommended Therapy

- **Plasticity Therapy (Intensive Program)** – recommended to begin **as soon as possible** to support information processing and adaptive development.

Notes on External Testing

The recommended analyses are conducted through **Neurazon (Canada)**, a bioinformatics company partnered with accredited international laboratories. These are **suggestions**, not mandatory, and are **not carried out directly through EICADD Center**.

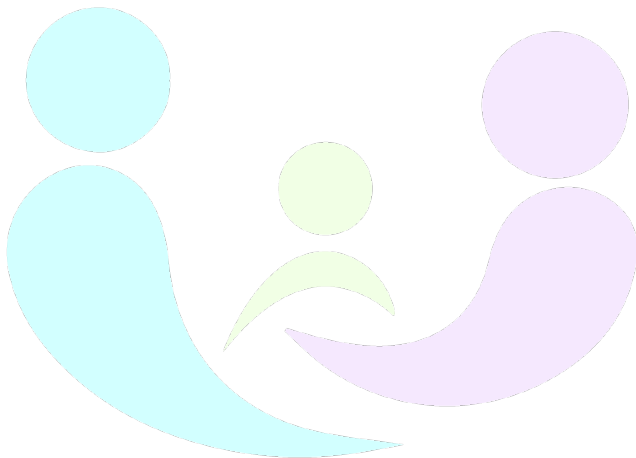
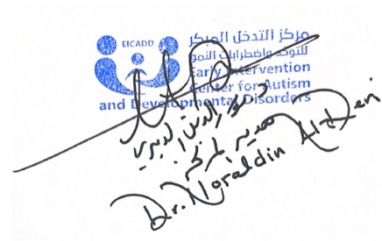
