

Director's Report on Developmental Progress Assessment

Overview:

Sheikh Mohammad Al Naemi was reassessed on May 28th, 2025. The child has demonstrated **significant improvement** following the initial intervention protocols. Nonetheless, **information processing delays** and **developmental delays** continue to impact his **learning and cognitive flexibility**. While the child does not present with autism spectrum features, learning difficulties remain a concern and require continued structured support. Further analysis will help tailor the intervention plan based on internal absorption and growth factor responses.

Recommended Plan:

1) Development Protocol for Information Processing

- Continue structured intervention for **4 months**
- Reassess progress **in person** at the end of the protocol
- Reestablish cognitive and learning baselines
- Adjust the therapeutic plan as needed

2) Main Recommended Analysis (via Neurazon – Canada):

3) Recommended Therapy After Determining the Causes:

- **Neuroplasticity Therapy (2–3 sessions per week)**
 - Intensive cognitive retraining and memory enhancement
 - Targeting executive functioning, attention, and working memory


