## **EICADD Center – Developmental Progress Assessment**

#### Overview

Rahaf visited our center for a developmental progress assessment. The evaluation showed information processing delays and developmental delays, along with acquired features of autism resulting from biological variants affecting development, as confirmed in the previous precision health analysis performed externally through Neurazon (Canada). Rahaf has shown significant improvement on the first protocol, demonstrating strong responsiveness to intervention and a high potential for continued developmental progress. Further assessment is required to fully determine the underlying causes and establish the next stages of her long-term intervention plan.

#### Recommended Plan

## 1) Development Protocol for Information Processing

- Continue the protocol for 4 months, followed by an in-person reassessment.
- Reevaluate progress and establish a new baseline at the next visit.
- Continue the structured intervention plan consistently throughout the 4 months.
- 2) Recommended Tests Through Neurazon (Canada)

(To be determined based on the next evaluation)

Depending on Rahaf's progress, the following may be recommended:

- **Precision Health Analysis** saliva sample (4-month turnaround)
- Neuronal Growth Factors Absorption Analysis (NGF) hair sample (2-month turnaround)

These tests provide deeper insight into developmental, metabolic, and neurological pathways influencing progress.

#### Note:

The recommended tests are conducted through **Neurazon** (**Canada**), a bioinformatics company partnered with accredited international laboratories. These are **external**, **optional** assessments not performed directly through our center.

## 3) Recommended Therapy

- Plasticity Rehabilitation Therapy (intensive program)
- Occupational Therapy (OT) intensive plan
- Speech Therapy (ST) intensive plan
- Weekly **online supervision** for the therapy plan if the child remains in **Libya**, ensuring continuity of care and correct implementation at home.
