Director's Report on Developmental Progress Assessment

Overview:

Fahad Al Sultan was assessed in person at our center. The child has shown significant improvement on the implemented protocol. Current findings indicate developmental delays with acquired features of autism, attributed to variants affecting brain development and white matter integrity as identified in a previous **Precision Health Analysis** conducted by Neurazon (Canada).

The child's progress demonstrates responsiveness to intervention, and further targeted analysis is required to support ongoing development.

Recommended Plan:

1. **Development Protocol for Information Processing:**
 - Continue for 4 months, followed by reevaluation (preferably in person).
 - Reassess the plan and establish an updated baseline.
 - Continue with the tailored intervention plan.
2. **Recommended Tests:**
 - Please refer to the previous report and assessment by Neurazon (Canada).
 - Note: These analyses are not conducted at EICADD directly.
3. **Recommended Therapy:**
 - Intensive **Neuroplasticity Rehabilitation Therapy** to support brain development and functional improvement.


