

Director's Report on Developmental Progress Assessment

Assessment

Ibrahim was assessed in person at our center on 29-04-2025.

The evaluation findings revealed:

- **Information Processing Delays**
- **Developmental Delays**

At this stage, the developmental profile indicates the need for structured and consistent intervention to support cognitive, motor, and communication development.

This assessment provides a developmental and functional analysis for therapy planning and is not intended as a final medical diagnosis.

Ibrahim demonstrates early potential for improvement with targeted multidisciplinary therapy.

Recommended Plan

1) Development Protocol for Information Processing

- Initiate a structured and age-appropriate intervention plan focusing on early communication skills, cognitive engagement, and sensory-motor integration.
- **Duration:** 4 months
- **Reevaluation:** Preferably in person after completion of the protocol to assess progress and update the developmental baseline.
- **Goal:** Enhance information processing speed, sensory regulation, and early social and communication skills.

2) Main Recommended Analysis

- **Future Testing Considerations:**
Based on the outcome of the next evaluation, further detailed analysis such as precision health analysis or neuronal absorption screening may be recommended to better understand underlying factors.

3) Main Recommended Therapy


- **Occupational Therapy (OT) Sessions:**
2 sessions per week focused on:
 - Sensory integration
 - Gross and fine motor skills development
 - Adaptive behavior support
- **Speech Therapy (ST) Sessions:**
2 sessions per week focusing on:
 - Early receptive and expressive language stimulation
 - Communication readiness skills
 - Feeding therapy if necessary

Follow-Up Plan

- **Reassessment:**
After 4 months of structured therapy to reassess progress across developmental domains and adjust therapy plans accordingly.
- **Continuous Monitoring:**
Documentation of therapy sessions, therapist observations, and parental feedback will help guide necessary changes and provide early detection of any additional support needs.
- **Important Note:**
This evaluation is for developmental and therapeutic guidance and does not represent a final medical diagnosis. Early structured intervention remains critical to optimize Ibrahim's developmental trajectory.
