Overview:

Fayzah was assessed online for a developmental progress evaluation. The findings indicate information processing delays and intellectual developmental delays, leading to acquired features of autism. However, she does not score as a case of autism.

Recommended Plan:

- 1. Development Protocol for Information Processing
 - o Implement the protocol for 4 months, then reassess, preferably in person.
 - o Reevaluate the plan and establish a baseline.
 - o Continue with the intervention plan.
- 2. Main Recommended Analyses (through Neurazon Canada):
 - Please refer to their report and assessment. These are not done at EICADD.
- 3. Therapy
 - o Neuroplasticity rehabilitation therapy (intensive to start as soon as possible).
