Assessment

Selin Alfadhel was assessed in person and has shown **great improvement** on the initial intervention protocol. She is now ready for the next step of her developmental plan. The child presents with **information processing delays** and **developmental delays** as a result of a genetic variant found in previous testing. Further analysis is recommended to address underlying causes and optimize her intervention.

Recommended Plan

1. Development Protocol for Information Processing

- Continue the targeted **Development Protocol** for **4 months**, followed by a reassessment (preferably in person).
- Reevaluate the plan and establish a new baseline after the reassessment.
- Continue with the intervention plan based on progress.

2. Main Recommended Analysis (*Through Neurazon – Canada*)

- Please refer to their report. These analyses are not done at EICADD.

3. Recommended Therapy

- **Neuroplasticity Rehabilitation Therapy**
 - If staying for a couple of months in Jordan: **2 Speech Therapy (ST), 2 Occupational Therapy (OT), and 2–3 Neuroplasticity sessions per week.**
 - If staying for a short period (e.g., two weeks): **Intensive daily neuroplasticity therapy** is recommended.
 - Preferably, the child should remain for a **longer duration** to achieve optimal results.
