Overview

Hessa Abdalla was assessed in person at our center. She has **information processing delays** and **developmental delays**that have led to **autism features**. According to the **Precision Health Analysis performed by Neurazon (Canada)**, autism-linked genetic variants were identified, indicating a biological component. Hessa showed **great improvement on the first protocol**. Further assessment is recommended to refine the intervention plan.

Recommended Plan

- 1. Development Non-medicinal Protocol for Information Processing
- Apply for 4 months, then reassess in person.
- Reevaluate the plan and establish a clear baseline.
- Continue and adjust the intervention according to progress.
- 2. Main Recommended Analyses
 - Please refer to Nueroazon's report and assessment. These analyses are not done at EICADD.
- 3. Recommended Therapy
- Neuroplasticity rehabilitation therapy: 2 to 3 sessions per week.






