Director's Report on Developmental Progress Assessment

Overview

Khaled visited our center for a developmental progress assessment. The evaluation indicates the presence of **information processing delays** and **acquired autism features**, which are currently believed to be **secondary to underlying developmental delays**.

These findings are consistent with what was previously demonstrated in the child's **MRI and EEG reports**, which showed indicators supporting a neurological and developmental basis for the current profile. At this stage, the child **does not meet the criteria for true classical autism**, and the presentation is better explained by neurological and developmental delays.

The child **requires further assessment** to better identify the underlying biological contributors and to refine the intervention plan accordingly.

Recommended Plan

1) Development Non-Medicinal Protocol for Information Processing

- Apply the protocol for **4 months**, followed by a comprehensive reassessment, preferably **in person**.
- Reevaluate the intervention plan and establish a **clear baseline** for progress tracking.
- Continue with the structured **non-medicinal intervention program**.

2) Main Recommended Analyses (External – Through Neurazon Canada)

All recommended analyses are conducted through **Neurazon (Canada)**, a bioinformatics company partnered with accredited international laboratories worldwide.

3) Recommended Therapy

- **Plasticity rehabilitation therapy** is recommended in **later stages**, once the child is neurologically and developmentally ready for more intensive neuroplastic stimulation.
