Assessment Summary:

Zaid was assessed on 25-06-2025. He presents with **information processing delays** and **developmental delays**, primarily as a result of **Down syndrome**. Despite these underlying challenges, **Zaid has shown significant improvement** after the initial intervention protocols. He does **not currently meet the criteria for autism**, and his developmental trajectory remains open for further progress. However, additional analysis is still recommended to further individualize his care.

Recommended Plan:



1. Development Protocol for Information Processing

- Continue the non-medicinal development protocol.
- Reassess after 4 months, preferably in person.
- Reestablish the developmental baseline.
- Adjust and continue the intervention plan accordingly.

2. Recommended Tests (through Neurazon - Canada):

- Neuronal Growth Factors Absorption Analysis
 - o Focused on understanding nutrient and neurodevelopmental absorption
 - o Hair sample required
 - Estimated turnaround: 2 months (business days)
 - Recommended to repeat every 6–12 months

3. Recommended Therapy after Determining the Causes:

- **Mitotherapy**: 2 light therapy (LT) sessions per week
