

Director's Report on Developmental Progress Assessment

Date of Visit: 25-06-2025

Child's Name: Ahmad Feras Al Faqir

Date of Birth: 11-05-2018

Overview:

Ahmad was assessed at our center and presents with **information processing delays** and **developmental delays** leading to signs of **hyperlexia**, more specifically aligned with **Hyperlexia Type 2**. These are classified as **acquired features of autism**. While not diagnosed as autism, these features indicate an altered developmental trajectory that requires targeted intervention. Further analysis is needed to determine the underlying causes.

Recommended Plan:

- 1. Development Protocol for Information Processing:
 - Continue with the protocol for 4 months, followed by an in-person reevaluation
 - Reassess to establish a new developmental baseline
 - Adjust and continue the intervention based on results

2. Recommended Tests (Canada-based):

- Please refer to their report and assessment. These tests are not done at EICADD.
- 3. Recommended Therapy (After Determining the Causes):
 - Mitotherapy: 2 light therapy (LT) sessions per week
 - Occupational Therapy: 2 sessions per week
 - Speech Therapy: 1 session per week
 - Neuroplasticity Rehabilitation Therapy: Intensive, available in UAE or when accessible in Jordan
