Overview:

Amjad was evaluated at our center due to **Information Processing Delays, Intellectual Developmental Delays, and Global Developmental Delays**. These challenges have led to **acquired features of autism**. While this is not a definitive diagnosis, further evaluation and refined interventions are critical for his progress.

Recommended Plan:

1) Development Protocol for Information Processing:

- Implement a structured, non-chemical protocol for **information processing delays**.
- Conduct this protocol for **4 months**, followed by an **in-person reevaluation**.
- Establish a clear **baseline** to monitor progress and determine further needs.
- Continue the intervention plan consistently.

2) Main Recommended Analysis (via Neurazon – Canada):

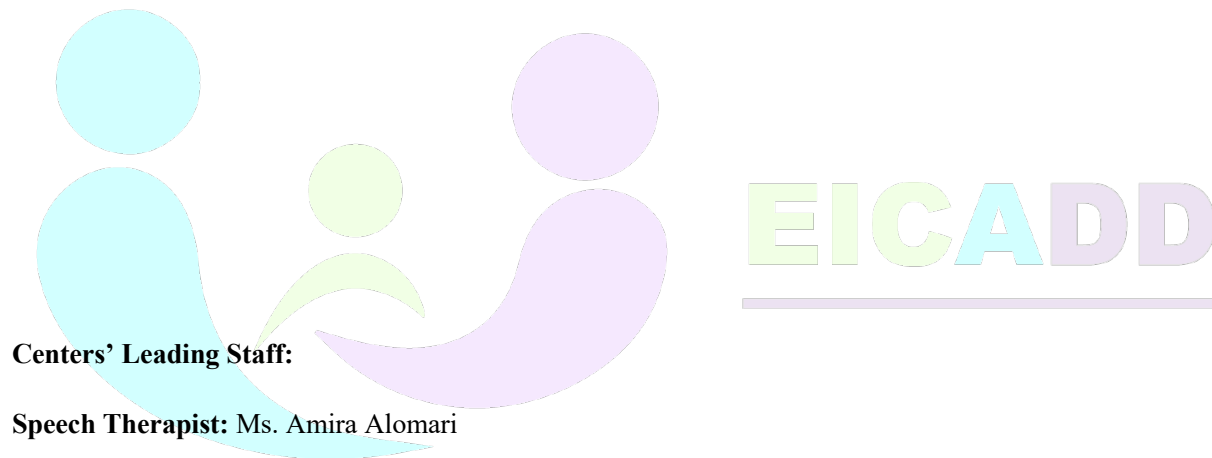
3) Recommended Therapy After Determining the Causes:

- **Neuroplasticity Rehabilitation Therapy (Later Stages):** A program focusing on enhancing neural connections and functional brain networks.
- **Speech and Occupational Therapy (2 sessions each per week):**

- **Speech Therapy (2ST):** To improve language and communication skills.
- **Occupational Therapy (2OT):** To support daily living activities and motor planning.
