### **Overview**

Eliana was assessed at our center on 03-09-2025. The evaluation revealed **information processing delays** and **developmental delays** that are concerning for her age. While she does **not score as a case of autism**, she is considered **at risk** and in need of **early and immediate intervention**. Further analyses are required to understand the underlying causes and to create a well-structured developmental program tailored to her needs.

#### **Recommended Plan**

## 1) Development Protocol for the Information Processing

- Implement a 4-month structured developmental protocol focusing on information processing.
- Conduct a **reevaluation after 4 months**, preferably in person.
- Establish a **baseline** during reevaluation for measurable tracking.
- Continue and adjust the intervention plan as necessary.

## 2) Main Recommended Analyses (through Neurazon - Canada)

## 3) Therapy

- Neuroplasticity rehabilitation therapy: Intensive sessions to begin as soon as possible.
- Therapy should focus on strengthening cognitive processing, speech, and adaptive developmental skills.

### **Conclusion**

Eliana demonstrates **information processing and developmental delays** that warrant **early and intensive intervention**. Although she does not meet autism criteria at this stage, she is **vulnerable to developing further challenges** if intervention is delayed. The recommended therapies and external analyses will help clarify contributing factors and support her developmental progress. A **reevaluation in 4 months** is essential to monitor improvement and adjust the plan accordingly.
