

Director's Report on Developmental Progress Assessment

Overview:

Adam Rami was assessed at our center on 14-09-2025. The evaluation revealed signs of information processing delays and developmental delays that are progressing toward hyperlexia, closer to Hyperlexia Type 3 but not fully established. Importantly, Adam does not meet the criteria for autism. However, further analyses are required to better understand the underlying causes and to establish a comprehensive intervention plan.

Recommended Plan:

1. Development Protocol for Information Processing

- Initiate a targeted protocol for **4 months**.
- Reevaluate the child in person at the end of the period.
- Establish a baseline during reassessment and adjust accordingly.
- Continue with the intervention plan for developmental support.

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2. Recommended Tests through Neurazon (Canada):

3. Recommended Therapy

- **Neuroplasticity Rehabilitation Therapy** (2–3 sessions per week) to enhance information processing and developmental functioning.
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Conclusion:

This is not a final diagnosis but an ongoing developmental evaluation. Adam shows potential for improvement with structured protocols and therapy. His current delays do not categorize him under autism, but close monitoring and targeted interventions are required to optimize his developmental trajectory.


