Overview:

Afnan was assessed at our center and presented with **information processing delays and developmental delays**, which are currently leading to **features of acquired autism**. At this stage, the assessment highlights the need for further analyses to better understand the underlying causes and to refine intervention strategies.

Recommended Plan:

1. Development Protocol for Information Processing



- Implement a structured developmental protocol for a duration of 4 months.
- Reevaluate the child after 4 months, preferably in person, to establish a baseline and adjust the plan accordingly.
- Continue with the intervention plan consistently to support developmental progress.

2. Recommended Tests through Neurazon (Canada):

3. Recommended Therapy

- Neuroplasticity Rehabilitation Therapy:

With continued intervention and proper follow-up through external testing, there is potential for meaningful improvement. A reassessment in 4 months is essential to track progress.
