**Director's Report on Developmental Progress Assessment**

#### Overview:

The child was evaluated at our center on 17-06-2025. The assessment revealed **information processing delays**, **cognitive developmental delays**, and noticeable **learning difficulties** that impact the child's ability to integrate, retain, and apply information effectively in structured learning environments.

These findings highlight the need for a multi-layered developmental support plan that not only targets cognitive development but also investigates potential biomedical or physiological factors that may be contributing to the child's challenges. Further analysis is essential to fully understand the underlying causes and guide more targeted interventions.

### **Recommended Plan:**



## 1. Development Protocol for Information Processing:

- Begin a structured developmental protocol focused on information processing for a period of 4 months.
- o After 4 months, the child should be reassessed (preferably in person) to evaluate progress and establish a new developmental baseline.
- o Continue or adjust the intervention plan based on the outcomes of the reevaluation.
- 2. Recommended Tests (conducted through Neurazon Canada):

- 3. Recommended Therapy After Determining the Causes:
  - Begin intensive neuroplasticity rehabilitation therapy (2–3 sessions per week), focusing on strengthening brain connectivity, cognitive flexibility, and learning readiness skills.
