

Director's Report on Developmental Progress Assessment

Overview:

Baderaldeem visited our center for a developmental assessment. The evaluation indicated **Information Processing Delay, intellectual developmental delays, and motor developmental delays**. These challenges are associated with **white matter delays and incomplete myelination**, as confirmed by previous MRI reports presented by the parents.

At this stage, Baderaldeem **does not score as a case of autism**, and the developmental delays appear primarily neurological in origin rather than behavioral.

Recommended Plan:

1. **Development Protocol for Information Processing:**
 - Continue the protocol for 4–6 months, followed by a reassessment, preferably in person.
 - Establish a new baseline during the next evaluation.
 - Continue with the tailored intervention plan based on observed progress.
2. **Main Recommended Analysis (After 4–6 Months):**
 - Further analyses will be considered based on the results of the next assessment.
3. **Main Recommended Therapy:**
 - Additional therapy recommendations will be made after the next evaluation to target motor and cognitive development effectively.

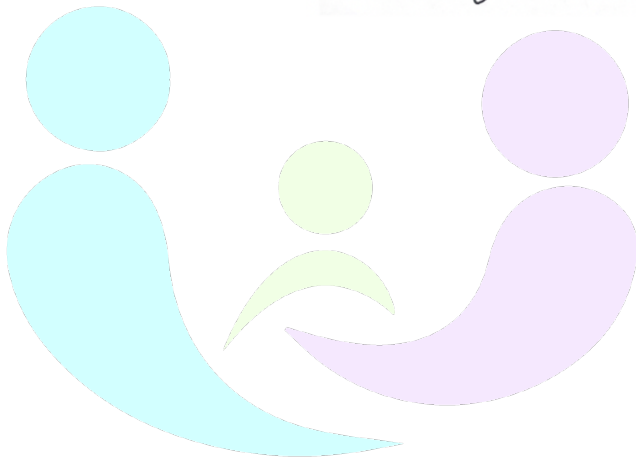
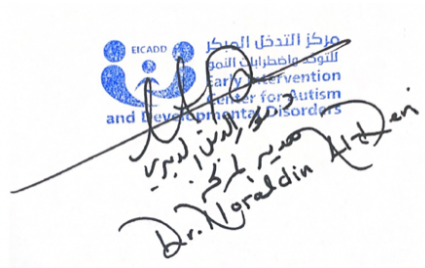
